Background

Official figures for some second level domains in dot-au for 1994-99 and 2002-04 are not publicly available.

Figures are for domain name registrations and thus do not necessarily indicate the number of sites. A particular registration may not have a corresponding site that is 'live' on the web, for example because the registrant do not proceed with plans to launch a site or instead registered the domain name merely to acquire an email address that is independent of an ISP or webmail service. Some entities have pointed multiple domain names to a particular site; there is thus no strict name-site equivalence. The Australian Bureau of Statistics initial *Internet Activity Report* (March 2001) noted that Australian ISPs claimed to be hosting some 101,000 "business and government" sites at the end of the September quarter in 2000. That figure is considerably smaller than the over 222,000 .com.au, .gov.au and net.au names in the registry at that time.





Graph 2: key dot-au second level domains




Graph 3: growth of .com.au 2LD, 1995-2004






Graph 5: growth of .org.au and net.au 2LDs, 1995-2004 *





Graph 6: growth of .au 2LDs other than .com.au *





Graph 7: growth of smaller 2LDs in dot-au *


